

## **Beaverbrook Heritage Conservation District Study**

### **Project Overview:**

In January 2026, City of Ottawa Heritage Planning staff received direction to complete a Heritage Conservation District Study for Beaverbrook, based on the results of the [Beaverbrook Heritage Conservation District Feasibility Assessment](#).

The goal of the Heritage Conservation District Study is to formally evaluate Beaverbrook against the Ontario Heritage Act's designation criteria and develop a Heritage Conservation District Plan that address the area's cultural heritage value.

### **Project Timing:**

City of Ottawa Heritage Planning staff are beginning work on this project, starting with field work to document the neighbourhood and create an inventory of properties. Staff will be in the area over the coming weeks to take photographs.

A final Heritage Conservation District study is tentatively scheduled to be presented to the City's Built Heritage Committee by the end of 2027.

### **Public Participation and Public Engagement:**

Heritage Planning Staff will be recruiting members of the public to participate in a Community Advisory Group (CAG) for this project. The goal of the CAG is to offer local expertise and advice to the City's Heritage Planning staff over the course of the project. Members will be expected to participate in approximately 5 – 10 meetings throughout 2026 and 2027, starting in fall 2026.

Further details on CAG participation are forthcoming and will be shared with the Ward Councillor's office and the KBCA.
